





Ordered by the Committee of Direction in Court 13<sup>th</sup> August 1723 -  
For the better regulation of the Treasury

- 1<sup>st</sup> That the money in the Treasury be kept in 2 purses a black one & a red one -
- 2<sup>d</sup> That all money paid into the Treasury be paid into the Black Purse
- 3<sup>d</sup> That at the close of every Term the balance in the Black Purse be transferred into the Red Purse -
- 4<sup>th</sup> That all warrants for money be made payable out of the Black Purse -
- 5<sup>th</sup> That no money be paid out of the Red Purse unless under the special direction of an Ordinance -
- 6<sup>th</sup> That a Day Book be kept at the Treasury in which every receipt shall be entered -
- 7<sup>th</sup> That an account Book shall be kept at the Treasury in which an account shall be opened with each member -
- 8<sup>th</sup> That a Docket or Ledger be kept at the Red Purse in which shall be entered every receipt & disbursement into & out of that Branch of the Treasury -
- 9<sup>th</sup> That a Docket or Ledger be kept at the Black Purse in which shall be entered every receipt & disbursement into & out of that branch of the Treasury -
- 10<sup>th</sup> That a Copy of these orders be attached to the 4 Books of the Treasury -
