SPECIAL CONVOCATION FOR CALL TO THE BAR

Candidates for Call to the Bar will be seated in Convocation Hall in proper order before 2 p.m.

The Osgoode Hall Legal and Literary Society will hold a special meeting at 2 p.m. at which Honour Award Keys will be presented to 9 students in recognition of their outstanding contribution to the student activities of the School. Mr. W. J. Beaton, K.C., Chairman of the Legal Education Committee will present the Awards.

The Treasurer and Benchers and their guests, The Honourable Mr. Justice Kerwin of the Supreme Court of Canada and The Chief Justice of the High Court, will then enter and take their places on the dais. Candidates for Call and guests will rise when the Benchers enter.

Mr. W. J. Beaton, K.C., will then present the candidates.

Mr. Cyril F. H. Carson, K.C., Treasurer of the Law Society will Call the candidates to the Bar and confer the degree of Barrister-at-Law. The Treasurer will present the following Medals:

Silver Medal - to Mr. John Hamilton Cameron Clarry

and award the following Scholarships:

The Chancellor Van Koughnet Scholarship - to Mr. J. N. Bartlet

The Matthew Wilson Memorial Scholarship - to Mr. B.C.F. Fraser

The Clara Brett Martin Memorial Scholarship - to Mr. W. E. Ward.

The Treasurer will also present the first prize in the Wallace Nesbitt Prize Essay Competition to Mr. R.A. Davies, past-President of the Osgoode Hall Legal and Literary Society, for his essay on "The Award of Statutory Maintenance in an Action for Divorce or to Declare the Nullity of Marriage," and the second prize to Mr. W.A. Macdonald for his essay on "The Law of Radio Broadcasting".

The Honourable Mr. Justice Kerwin of the Supreme Court of Canada will address the new members of the Bar and their guests.

Convocation will adjourn.

(There will be a short interlude while the Court is set up.)

The Honourable Mr. Justice Gale of the Supreme Court of Ontario will enter and take his place on the dais. Everyone will rise and remain standing until the Court is declared open.

The oaths will be administered and Mr. Justice Gale will address the new members of the Bar. When Mr. Justice Gale retires everyone will stand.

Candidates will sign the Rolls and anyone who wishes may retire during this part of the ceremony.

A Reception and Garden Party will be held on the West Lawn for all the new members of the Bar and their guests. (If the weather is unfavourable the Reception will be held in the Rotunda, centre wing.)
