## 1982 IN REVIEW

There were 226,565 individuals assisted by Duty Counsel across the Province compared with 225,960 last year.

## PAMPHLET REVISIONS

We have been informed that pamphlets produced by Community Legal Education Ontario — a community legal clinic funded by the Ontario Legal Aid Plan — are now out of date and should be removed from circulation. These pamphlets

are being revised and supplies will again be available for distribution before the fall.

## FOUR NEW CLINICS

The number of community legal clinics across the Province rose to 39 recently with the opening of four new clinics in St. Catharines, Orillia, Ottawa and Toronto.

In St. Catharines, Niagara North Community Legal Assistance will provide services in the areas of workmen's compensation, unemployment insurance, welfare and immigration. Simcoe Legal Services Clinic in Orillia will provide a range of summary legal advice and information to individuals, while West End Legal Services in Ottawa will assist those with problems involving landlord-tenant disputes, welfare and other administrative law problems. Scarborough Community Legal Services will provide a full range of services to individuals in the Scarborough area.
