CONVOCATION FOR CALL TO THE BAR

Thursday, 21st June 1951 at 2 p.m.

Candidates for Call to the Bar will be seated in Convocation Hall in proper order before 2 p.m.

The Osgoode Hall Legal and Literary Society will hold a special meeting at 2 p.m. at which Honour Award Keys will be presented to 8 students in recognition of their outstanding contribution to the student activities of the School. Mr. W.J. Beaton, K.C., Chairman of the Legal Education Committee will present the Awards.

The Treasurer and Benchers and their guest, The Honourable Leslie M. Frost, K.C., Prime Minister of Ontario, will then enter and take their places on the dais. Candidates for Call and guests will rise when the Benchers enter.

Mr. W.J. Beaton, K.C. will then present the candidates.

Mr. Cyril F.H. Carson, K.C., Treasurer of the Law Society will confer upon the candidates the degree of Barrister-at-Law and call them to the Bar. The Treasurer will present the following Medals:

The Honourable Leslie M. Frost, K.C., Prime Minister of Ontario, will address the new members of the Bar and their guests.

Convocation will adjourn.

(There will be a short interlude while the Court is set up.)

The Honourable The Chief Justice of Ontario will enter and take his place on the dais. Everyone will rise and remain standing until the Court is declared open.

Mr. W.J. Beaton, K.C. will present the candidates.

The oaths will be administered and the Chief Justice will address the new members of the Bar. When the Chief Justice retires everyone will stand.

Candidates will sign the Rolls and anyone who wishes may retire during this part of the ceremony.

A Reception and Garden Party will be held on the West Lawn for all the new members of the Bar and their guests. (If the weather is unfavourable the Reception will be held in the Rotunda, centre wing).

The guests will be received by The Treasurer and Mrs. Carson, The Prime Minister and Mrs. Frost, Mr. W.J. Beaton, K.C. and Mrs. Cameron, and the Dean and Mrs. Smalley-Baker.
