6th That a Day Book be kept at the Treasury in which every receipt shall be entered.

8th That a Docket or Ledger be kept at the Red Purse in which shall be entered every ^{Receipt} and Disbursement into and out of that Branch of the Treasury.

9th That a Docket or Ledger be kept at the Black Purse in which shall be entered every receipt and disbursement into and out of that Branch of the Treasury.

10th That a copy of these orders be attached to the four Books of the Treasury.
